

Wheel Rims

APPLICATION

Peak Trailers offer wheels that are centre nave or have a positive or negative offset. With a centre nave wheel the track and over hub face measurements are equal. A positive offset means the mounting surface of the wheel moves outwards from the trailer resulting in a track measurement smaller than the over hub face. A negative offset is the reverse. *Please refer to the illustration overleaf A, B and C.*

To calculate the stud pattern or PCD (pitch circle diameter) of a wheel please refer to the diagrams (Fig. 1, 2 and 3) or the formula overleaf.

The 8" and 10" wheels are usually finished in white, the 12", 13" and 13" in silver and the 16" in black. *Please check on the stock situation when ordering.*
